Karin Freeman has been a member of the PYLUSD Board of Education since 1989 and also served as a member of the Board for the Yorba Linda School District from 1986 to 1989 prior to the merger of the Placentia and Yorba Linda school districts. Additional areas of service include participation as a member of the Board for the North Orange County Regional Occupational Program (NOCROP) since 1991, Orange County School Boards Association Board of Directors since 1993, Orange County Committee on School District Organization since 2007 and California School Boards Association Delegate Assembly since 2002. Professional recognitions include 1990 Recipient of Honor for the Orange County Commission on Status of Women as well as the 2005 Marian Bergeson Award as the Outstanding Board Member in Orange County.
